# ADDITIONAL WAYPOINTS IN TIMOR-LESTE

#### 1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 This AIRAC SUP describes additional waypoints for use in Timor-Leste supporting the planned introduction of RNP (and AR) approaches, RNP1 SIDs and STARS on AIRAC 2206, and helicopter operations.

#### 2 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Timor-Leste is planning on the introduction of RNP and RNP AR approaches and terminal procedures during 2022. This AIRAC SUP details new waypoints required for RNP AR operations, as of a result of SIDs for departures to Australia, and the planned publication of STARs for arrivals into Dili from Australia.
- 2.2 The waypoints published in this SUP shall be available for use on AIRAC 2203.
- 2.3 This SUP replaces SUP 03/22 which incorrectly listed DEBAZ.
